I understand that I must have adequate 3rd party insurance to RYYC standards and sail with the following safety equipment- a suitable anchor and warp (20 metres), compass, paddle, knife, flares, whistle and buoyancy aid per person. In order to prevent damage to other craft, the dinghy committee recommends that masts are lowered at the end of the racing season.
