

## **Changes to RYYC SI's 2011 Season**

### **9 Marks**

Marks 1,2,3,4,5,6,8,9,0,U,A,B,C&D will be cylindrical yellow buoys numbered accordingly

18.2 Boats shall be eligible for 1 discard after each 4 races which are sailed within a series. Races which are not started, or which are abandoned after the start and for which no result is obtained, shall not count towards these 4 races. (Therefore 1 discard after 4 races, 2 discards after 8 races, etc)

### **Appendix Rule 1 – Officer Of the Day**

Any boat acting as Officer Of the Day (OOD) shall score '2 points' for any race in which they would have normally been eligible to race in. If however the boat enters racing and betters that score (i.e. comes first) then that better score shall count.

### **Appendix Rule 2 – Missing Marks**

In the event that critical marks are substantially displaced or missing [e.g.1/2/9 and 6 which appears in 2/3rds of courses] which compromise the setting of a suitable course from the RYYC Courses list, the race officer **in consultation with** a Flag Officer may set a course using the alphanumeric buoy designations. It should be made clear to the fleet that action is being applied, with reasonable notice prior to commencement of starting sequence.

### **Appendix Rule 3 -- RYYC Long Distance Races**

Boats competing in RYYC Long Distance races [ Aimee and Dowsing races] consequently being unable to participate in scheduled RYYC series races will be credited with 2 points in those races missed. This excludes any weekend mini-series' and does not count as a second place in the event of the results being used in a tie-break situation for awards.
