APPLICATION FOR SAFETY CERTIFICATE 2012

I hereby apply for a Safety Certificate in respect
of my Yacht Class Sail Number.....

I certify that my yacht complies with the safety regulations specified in the Class Rules and with the Safety Regulations of the RYYC (as confirmed below).

I understand that any Safety Certificate granted will become invalid if the yacht at any time ceases to comply with the Safety Regulations and that non-compliance with the regulations renders my yacht liable to disqualification whilst racing, and deduction of points at the discretion of the protest committee.

Neither the establishment of these conditions, their use by the race organisers, nor the inspection of the yacht under these conditions in any way limits the absolute responsibility of the owner/competitor. The crew are nonetheless advised to satisfy themselves as to the experience of the skipper and the adequacy of all safety equipment and insurance arrangements.

I agree to permit the Sailing Committee or any person acting on its behalf to examine my yacht at any time to ensure compliance with the Safety Regulations.

6	Water Resistant Torch (in working order)
7	In addition to No 2 at least one Lifebuoy or Positive Buoyancy Aid within easy reach of the Helmsman
8	An Oar or Paddle at least one metre long
9	Operational VHF Radio
10	First Aid Kit
11	I understand that the Safety Certificate must be retained and shown to the Safety Checker.
