RACE OFFICER NOTES:

A "bay race" consists of one or more "bay courses".

A course is a round, a round is a course.

Mix courses from same horizontal line only.

Courses on any horizontal line can be used before or after each other.

Consider using shorter courses later in the race to facilitate shortening the race.

If any buoy is missing and no time to lay pellet, use any "possible" wind sector line.
