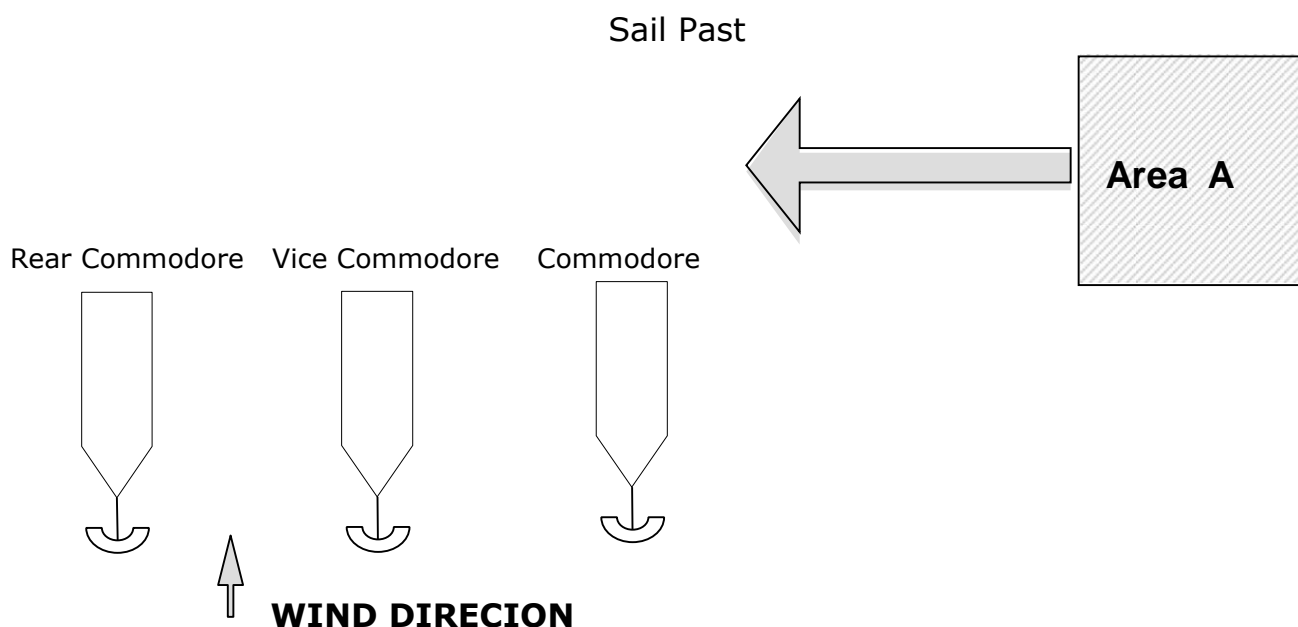

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS FLEET REVIEW

Saturday 4th August 2018

Start time: 09:00 HW: 10.01



The Fleet Review is scheduled to start at 09:00. Boats should assemble in Area A. The start of the sail past will be signalled by a VHF communication and a sound signal from the starting hut on the pier end. The fleet will be led by "Enigma". The sequence will be as follows:-

Cruisers	Enigma then in ascending handicap (fastest first)
National Squibs	in ascending sail numbers
Yorkshire One Designs	in ascending sail numbers
Contessa 26s	in ascending sail numbers
Dinghies	

Boats should pass to leeward of the flag officers, with a distance between yachts of three boat lengths.

The traditional salute involves the skipper/owners hailing "Iolanthe (for example) three cheers for the Commodore/Vice Commodore/Rear Commodore (Sail) Hip, hip, etc".

The Norman Cooke Cup will be awarded to the smartest sailing yacht / power vessel and crew, and will be presented on Friday August 10th at the Regatta Week Prizegiving.
