

RYYC EAST FARM COTTAGE

MEMBERS CAMPING RULES AND GUIDELINES - 2019

AVAILABILITY

Use of the Members' camping area is available only to those who accept and abide by these rules and who are:

RYYC members who have an immediate family member sailing, manning the safety boat, or using the other watersports equipment on that or the next day (only).

Or

RYYC members who have the Commodore's prior permission, who have been allocated specific BPDS responsibilities related to maintenance or sailing and who are undertaking those responsibilities.

RULES

1. Members' camping is allowed during the sailing season (only) when there are RYYC/BPDS organised activities/sailing taking place on that or the next day.

In addition, all Members may nominate one week during the sailing season when they may camp for a full week.

Members must pre-book all camping reservations with Charlotte in the office no later than the Thursday prior to the arrival weekend or 24 hours in advance on non-weekend bookings. Bookings to be made no more than 7 days in advance.

2. Camping fees – 2019

Tent only - £5.00

Caravan or Camper Van only - £6.00

Caravan or Camper Van with tent/awning - £7.00

Motor Homes - £8.00

In each case charges are per night on the site, regardless of whether a unit is attended or not. Fees include VAT, and are payable in advance via the office at the time of booking.

RULES (continued)

3. A 'Camping Unit' is defined as a TENT or CARAVAN or CAMPER VAN or MOTOR HOME with or without an awning.

a) 'Camping Units' must be parked with their tow bars or vehicle fronts facing outward.

b) All 'Camping Units' must be at least 15 Feet from the next unit.

c) Electric cables should only be laid along the perimeter fence and not across the field as this is hazardous.

d) 'Camping Units' must not be left unattended for 24 hours or more in any one stay except in an emergency.

e) Any member leaving units on site breaching these rules will forfeit the right to future camping.

4. There are a limited number of credit electricity points available. You should request this facility at the time of booking and not wait until arrival. There is no guarantee of booking a plot with electric available.

5. Members guests staying overnight or using their own 'Camping Unit' may do so by prior arrangement and will be charged £12 per night.

a) Guests are only allowed to stay for a maximum of 3 nights in any one year. The introducing member is responsible for payment of their guests' fees which are payable on arrival.

b) The member must be on site at all times the guests are on site.

c) Guests may not stay overnight in members camping units unless the responsible adult member is also present.

d) This is a member only facility. Visitors or guests should park in the car park by the clubhouse.

6. Drinking water taps around the paddock are only to be used for the supply of drinking water to appropriate containers. They are not washing off points or places to rinse your toilets out. Toilet and grey waste water should be emptied at the facility provided at the north east corner of the cottage.

7. All 'Camping Units' etc. and their contents, equipment and possessions are the responsibility of their owners. The RYYC does not and will not accept any liability for any loss or damage.

8. Dogs are welcome but must ALWAYS be kept on a lead in the paddock or car park. Please clean up after you pet and please do not use the pots from the transline or cottage to water them.

RULES (continued)

09. Open fires are not permitted on any part of the site or beach. BBQ's should be sited well away from flammable materials or liquids and must be at least 450mm above the ground. Please flush instant BBQ's with water before putting them on the ground or disposing of them. If using the cottage patio areas please clean it when you leave.

10. When using the shower block please rinse all sand off at the wash off point outside before entering. This will prevent sandy floors and blocked drains.

11. Anyone under the age of 16, cadet or otherwise:

- a) Must have a parent or guardian on site at all times.
- b) If using the shower block must have parental supervision.
- c) Must not be left unattended in a 'Camping Unit.'

12. All camping by club members must only be in the paddock, as the Regatta field may be booked for rallies. If you appear to be the last one to retire please make sure all the main gates are closed.

13. Electric tokens are available to purchase prior to arrival through the office or obtainable from nominated BPDS Committee Members.

GUIDELINES

All members are reminded that this facility is for your enjoyment and rules are made for the benefit of all, so please treat it and others as you would wish to be treated yourself.

All members are reminded that they should present a warm and friendly impression of the RYYC. If you do not happen to know someone entering the site, then you should politely enquire as to the reason of their visit and if it transpires they are not members and are not enquiring about the facilities they should be politely informed that it is a members only facility.

The cottage, kitchen and toilet facilities, and in fact the whole site is maintained on a self-help basis. We do not employ cleaners etc. so if you, your family or friends make a mess make sure you clean it up.
