## **POWERED BOATS:**

Applications from powered boats will only be accepted once safety boat rota/duties have been agreed with the Commodore or Rear Commodore Dinghies.

## **NOTES:**

1 Payment of berthing/launching fees is mandatory before a boat can compete in races organised by the RYYC. Results from any races sailed prior to payment of these fees will not count for series, trophy or season overall results.

2 Successful applicants will be allocated a specific plot within the compound.

3 In order to prevent damage to other craft, it is recommended that masts are lowered at the end of the racing season.

4 All boats, launching trailers and road trailers must be clearly identified. The RYYC reserves the right to remove any unidentified equipment.

5 Please keep your berthing and trailer area tidy. The RYYC reserves the right to move a boat or trailer and have the grass cut at a cost of £20 to the owner.

## **BYELAW 10:**

10 i) Members shall not keep craft on Club property otherwise than with permission subject to any conditions and on payment of such fees as may be indicated to the Member.

10 ii) If at any time fees for keeping a craft on Club property are left unpaid by a Member for a period in excess of one calendar month from demand any such permission shall be deemed to be revoked and the Committee may authorise the service of notice to the Member concerning any craft owned or purported to be owned by the Member. Such notice shall set out the information contained in the Schedule to these Byelaws as to action hereby authorised to be taken by or on behalf of the Club.

### **Schedule: Action authorised to be taken in respect of craft left on Club property to be contained in a notice sent under Item 10 above.**

- i) The craft is liable to be moved forthwith without any liability on the club for loss or damage whether as bailee or otherwise to another part of the Club premises including a part which is not secure
- ii) After one calendar month from the date on the notice the craft may be sold at the best price obtainable but without responsibility for not achieving the actual or believed value thereof and any monies owed to the club for whatever reason and any costs involved shall be deducted from the proceeds of sale.
- iii) If the craft fails to realise sufficient in cash to meet the amount of monies owing the Committee as above may recover any costs involved together with other monies owing as a debt.
- iv) If the craft is unsaleable the Committee may dispose or arrange for disposal of the craft by a contractor and recover any cost involved together with other monies owing as above as a debt.
- v) Any surplus funds after a sale of the craft shall be paid to the Member or former Member against a receipt confirming ownership of the craft up to the date of sale and in the absence of such a receipt for any reason the surplus shall be paid into the general account of the Club and remain available for repayment without interest for a period of 6 years.

**LEGAL LIABILITY:**

To the best of my knowledge the information I have given is accurate.

I understand that Yacht Racing can be dangerous and I agree that the Royal Yorkshire Yacht Club ('RYYC') has no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members or others, or for the loss of, or damage to any vessel or property.

I confirm I have adequate and suitable insurance.

Before racing I will ensure that my crew is aware of:

- this Declaration
- the importance of effecting appropriate personal insurance
- their responsibility in rules observance, and in particular wearing personal floatation and safety devices adequate for the conditions.

I agree to be bound by RYYC, Royal Yachting Association ('RYA') Prescriptions and other applicable rules.

My yacht, boat, dinghy or craft is available for inspection at any time without notice.

I understand and agree that any information given in this form and also any race entry application will be maintained on any RYYC computer and may be used or shared for all aspects of race organisation and publication of race results. No information will be used for marketing purposes, sold or shared with any third party not associated with this race entry or participation in sailing from the RYYC.
